



## Snow Pearls

Cascading snowflakes falling silently through the branches of evergreen adds a magic touch to holiday trees! DIY in minutes by stringing Fairfield's Poly-Fil® Biggie Bean Bag Filler on 30-gauge silver wire.

### What's Needed:

Poly-Fil® Biggie Bean Bag Filler- Fairfield World  
30 Gauge Wire (silver)- Craft Store  
Hot Glue Gun w/Glue Sticks

Flat Nose Pliers  
Wire Cutters

### How to Make It:



### Note:

The Poly-Fil® Biggie Bean Bag Filler is extremely light-weight. For this reason, we used a silver 30-gauge wire and not a clear filament. The wire not only adds weight but can be formed into a nifty hook.



### Step 1

Place the filler pieces, wire, flat nose pliers and wire cutters on a flat work surface.




### Step 2

Cut a piece of 4" wire from the spool. Using the flat nose pliers, form a small spiral at one end.



### Step 3

Slide a filler piece onto the wire from the opposite end of the spiral.




#### Step 4

Place a drop of hot glue on the spiral. Slide the filler piece over the glue.



#### Step 5

The glued spiral will hold the filler piece in place and create a finished bottom.



#### Step 6

Place a second drop of hot glue on the wire. Thread a second filler piece on the wire and slide it over the glued area.



#### Step 7

Continue gluing filler pieces on the wire. Snow Pearl strands can be made using 1, 2, 3 or more filler pieces. Keep in mind to adjust the length of wire used to accommodate the amount of filler pieces.

*We made our ornaments using 1, 2, or 3 filler pieces only as we had a small tree.*



#### Step 8

To make the hanger leave 1" of wire from the top of the last filler piece added. Cut off excess. Using the flat nose pliers, bend the remaining wire over to form the hook.



Snow Pearls look amazing hung from a tree or pine garland.
