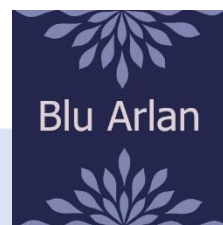


Celebrating Spring



Bunny Treat Cup

Our DIY Bunny Treat Cups make Easter entertaining a breeze. Easy to do, these adorable bunny cups can be filled with fresh fruit, seasonal salads, desserts or Easter sweets.

What's Needed:

Bunny Head Printables- Blu Arlan (included, scroll down)

12 Treat Cups- Spr!tz /Target

Permanent Double-Sided Tape- Scotch

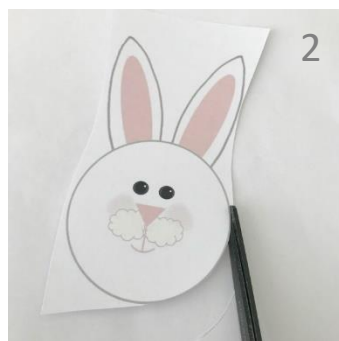
8" Non-Stick Scissor- Fiskars

Cotton Balls or White Pompoms

Glue Sticks- Gorilla

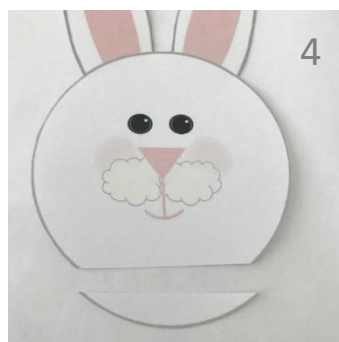
Hot Glue Gun

How To Make It:



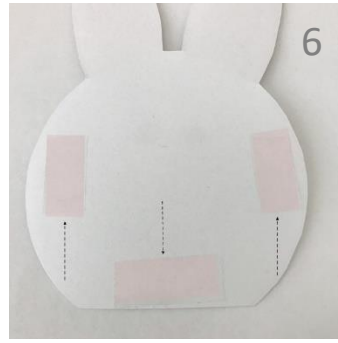
1-Download and print bunny printables on white cardstock (bunny sheet located below, 3 image sheet).

2- Cut out one bunny head for every treat cup. We used scissors but a craft knife works well too.



3- Place bunny heads, treat cups, cotton balls and double-sided tape on a flat work surface.

4- Bunny head can be attached with a round or flat chin. To create a flat chin cut 1/8" to 1/4" off the bottom of the head. *Cut chins will sit flush against the cups bottom.*



5- Slightly curve the bunny face so it sits flat on the cup. Use a wooden dowel or back of a pen to curve the paper.

6- Place three pieces of double-sided tape on the back of the bunny head. Head can also be hot glued if desired.



7- Place the bunny head over the cup's seam.

8- Press the taped areas against the cup to secure in place.



9- Slightly curve the bunny's ears using a dowel or the back of a pen.

10- Repeat the above steps to make all the bunny treat cups needed.



11- Hot glue one cotton ball or white pompom on each cup.

12- Cotton ball placement should be directly behind the head.



To create a Spring time presentation, line each cup with a few pieces of butter lettuce. Fill cups with fresh fruit, seasonal salads, strawberry shortcake or Easter sweets.
