



Easter Centerpieces

Creative centerpieces that last long after they're given. DIY by simply filling baskets with flowering potted plants, aromatic herbs and hand-painted bisque bunnies and eggs.

Potted House Plants or Herbs

1½" Ribbon 1 yard - Vintage or New

Plastic Wrap

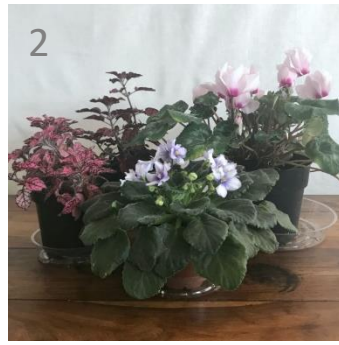


The inspiration for these centerpieces is to offer an alternative to using bulb plants for Easter and Mother's Day.

Try potted flowering house plants and herbs which can be kept indoor year-round or planted in a beloved garden box.



How To Make It:



1-Select a basket. For painting instructions see [bluarlan.com/ Holiday Spring](http://bluarlan.com/HolidaySpring) page/ Chalk Painted Basket PDF.
2- Pick what type of potted house plants or herbs will be used. Select different sizes to give height to the centerpiece and width to fill the basket.

3- Line the basket with clear wrap if pots do not have liners. Begin placing plants in the basket.
4- Try a few different placements for the plants in the basket to find the best configuration.

5- When selecting a ribbon, choose a colour and pattern that embraces Spring. Vintage ribbons offer unique detailing, colours and patterns.
6- We tied a simple bow on the basket's handle however, bows can be elaborate and placed where you like.

7, 8 - Insert Easter picks among the plants. *We hand-painted bisque eggs and bunnies. For instructions see [bluarlan.com Holiday Spring](http://bluarlan.com/HolidaySpring) page /Egg and Bunny PDF's.*
8- For a different variation we replaced the ribbon, its location and added additional picks.

9- Herb baskets make wonderful centerpieces for an Easter brunch or dinner.
