Quick, easy and fun to do our little spiders look fantastic everywhere. Use as a decoration, party favor or crafting project for kids.



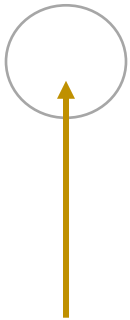
Spider Material List

½" Foam Balls
Chenille Stems
Wiggle and Foam Eyes
Black Feathers

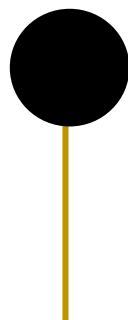
Aleene's Tacky Glue
Hot Glue Gun
Black Acrylic Paint
Paint Brush

Fiskars 8" Scissors
Fiskars Wire Cutters
Bamboo Skewers

Instructions



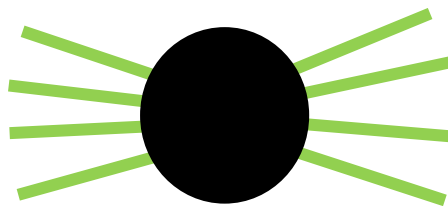
Step 1
Poke a bamboo skewer into the foam ball. This will enable the ball to be painted and dry in one step. Stand upright in a tall glass to hold.



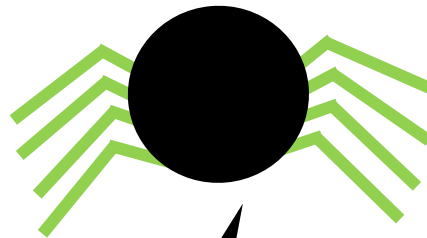
Step 2
Paint the foam ball with the black acrylic paint. Let dry.



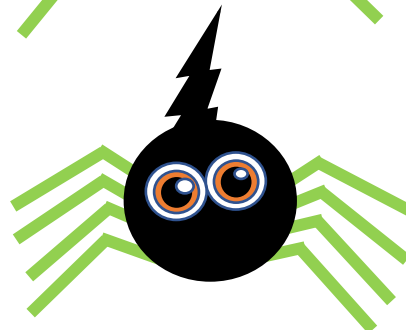
Step 3
Cut 8 pieces of chenille stem 2.5" long using the wire cutters.



Step 4
Pre-make 4 holes on each side of the ball with the skewer. Dip each piece of chenille in a drop of glue then insert in holes. Let glue dry.



Step 5
Bend each leg so spider will stand. Measure ¼" of stem from the body. Bend remaining stem down. Adjust legs.



Step 6
Hot glue eyes in place. To add hair, poke a hole in the top of the ball and glue a piece of feather in.

Note: Spiders love to sparkle. Try mixing in a few purple spiders with glitter stem legs for extra Halloween pizzazz.
