## Chione

Wrap Necklet

Make it today, wear it tonight.  
Modern DIY necklet that is super easy to make using manufactured beaded roping, jump rings, embroidery floss and a few special beads.

### What's Needed:

Manufactured Spiral Beaded Rope/Cord 1 to 2 yds (samples show silver and multi-colour)

Pendant Bead (sample shows bone ankh bead)- Lauren Trimming NYC

Embroidery Floss (white or turquoise)

Glass Beads 284.4cm (sample shows 56 pieces, white)

Jump Rings (2 pieces 6mm, 9 pieces 10 mm)

Lobster Clasp 15 mm (1 piece)

Nugget Beads (sample shows faux turquoise 11 pieces)

Crazy Glue

Bijou Tassel (hand-made instructions below)




Needle Nose Pliers, Scissors

### Note:



This necklet is made with a manufactured beaded and thread roping/cord that was purchased in a NYC bead shop (sorry no online store). Similar roping/cord can be found online. The amount of yardage to purchase will be determined by how it's to be worn. The sample above used 2 yards.

## How To Make It:



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1- Place desired length of beaded roping/cord on a flat work surface.

2- Remove the tape or cover from one end only. Note: tape was applied to keep rope/cord from unraveling.

3- Remove 1½" to 2" of beads from the cotton strands by lightly pulling the beads towards the end.

4- To secure the beads place a 3" piece of white embroidery floss behind the cotton strands.

5- Wrap the floss twice around the cotton strands directly under the beads. Make a double knot in the floss to hold in place. Do not cut excess off.

6- Divide the cotton floss in thirds and braid together.

7- Slip a 6mm jump ring onto the braided cotton strands. Fold the braided strands against the knotted floss to create a loop for the jump ring. Wrap the floss around the braided strands twice and double knot to secure. Cut excess strands and floss off. Place a drop of Crazy Glue on the knot.

8- Repeat for the second end.

9- Open one of the jump rings using a pair of needle nose pliers. Slip the lobster clasp on the ring and close.

10- Slip the other jump ring onto the clasp. The necklet portion of this project is now finished.

## How To Make The Beaded Tassel Slides:




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
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11- The Chione necklace features 8 beaded tassel sliders that are made using 10mm jump rings, glass beads and embroidery floss.

12- Place materials on a flat work surface.



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13- Open jump ring using needle nose pliers.

14- Slide glass beads on the rings. We used 6 beads. Adjust your count as needed.



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15- Close jump ring.

16- Cut two piece of floss 3" long. Place the two pieces of floss together and attach to the jump ring with a lark's head knot. Pull knot tight.



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17- Divide the four stands of floss in half. Thread two pieces of floss through a glass bead.

18- Knot floss to secure bead. Separate the strands of floss to create the tassel.



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19- Slip the ankh bead onto a jump ring.

20- Slide 4 bead tassels on one end of the beaded necklace followed by the ankh and then the remaining 4 bead tassels.



21- Push the bead tassels and ankh to the center of the necklace.

22- Pieces are moveable and can be slid in place for each unique wearing. Necklace can also be worn with or without the beaded tassels and ankh.

### How To Make The Chunky Chione Necklace:



A- The second version of the Chione necklace is more colourful and features chunky beads.

B- Place 2 yds of beaded roping, lobster clasp, jump rings and white floss on a flat work surface.



C- Follow steps 1 thru 10 above to create the necklet's closure.

D- If desired add a Bijou Tassel. Click the link below for instructions:

E- To attach the chunky beads simply place a line of Crazy Glue on the back of the bead. Do not be messy or touch the glue with fingers.

F- Starting from one end place the bead roping on top of the glue. Press beads down against glue using a tool. Let glue set a few seconds.



G- Continue gluing the chunky beads on the beaded roping (beads do not have to be spaced equally). Let glue dry.

Necklet is finished and is ready to be worn.
